

# 2023-2024 Wilson Hall Uniform Quick Guide

PS3 - 12th Grade

Wilson Hall's uniform policy exists to promote education in an environment that lessens distractions, increases a sense of community, and teaches the value of professional attire. To that end, the dress code will be followed; however, this dress code is meant to be a guide. The administration reserves the right to disallow anything that contradicts the spirit of the uniform dress code.

# **Shirts**

Male students must wear one of the following collared shirts tucked in on Monday-Thursday:

**MALES** 

- Polo: white, blue, navy, gray with WH logo
- Oxford/Pinpoint: white, blue, striped with WH logo

### Outerwear

Males may wear any of the following items with a collared Wilson Hall logo shirt underneath. Males may also wear the items below without a collared shirt (no colors from other tee shirts may be visible). However, the outer layer may not be removed at any time during the school day unless a collared uniform shirt is underneath. Excessively baggy sweatshirts are not permitted. Hoodies and non-logo shirts or sweaters are not permitted for grades 6-12. Any jacket, raincoat, or cold weather gear not listed below may be worn outside, but not in buildings.

- Navy or gray sweater or sweater vest with WH logo
- Navy or gray fleece with WH logo
- Navy, blue, white, or gray quarter zip with WH logo
- Navy or gray thermoplume (down) jacket with WH logo
- Navy blazer with WH logo
- Navy rain jacket with WH logo
- Crewneck Sweatshirts: navy, white, light blue, gray with WH logo
- WH Letterman jacket (not on Lands' End site)
- Tie in clear blue plaid

# Pants/Shorts

(MUST be longer than fingertips)

• Pants/Shorts (plain front): khaki, classic navy, light blue, gray

Khaki pants and shorts must be classic cut plain front cotton. Cargo pants, canvas work-style pants, and fishing shorts are not allowed.

# Footwear and Belts

- Shoes: closed toe shoes, boots, or athletic shoes. Crocs, slippers, and flip-flops are not permitted. Lower School must have closed-back shoes.
- Socks: ankle or crew in solid color white, navy, light blue, khaki, black, gray (not brightly colored or print)
- Belts: solid brown, solid black or Wilson Hall belts must be worn with pants and shorts with belt loops

# **Shirts**

Female students must wear one of the following collared shirts tucked in on Monday-Thursday:

**FEMALES** 

- Polo or Peter Pan collar shirt: white, blue, navy, gray with WH logo on shirt or collar
- Oxford/Pinpoint: white, blue with WH logo

#### **Outerwear**

Females may wear any of the following items with a collared Wilson Hall logo shirt underneath. Females may also wear the items below without a collared shirt (no colors from other clothing or undergarments may be visible). However, the outer layer may not be removed at any time during the school day unless a collared uniform shirt is underneath. Excessively baggy sweatshirts are not permitted. Hoodies and non-logo shirts or sweaters are not permitted for grades 6-12. Any jacket, raincoat, or cold weather gear not listed below may be worn outside, but not in buildings.

- Navy or gray sweater or sweater vest with WH logo
- Navy or gray fleece with WH logo
- Navy, blue, white, or gray quarter zip with WH logo
- Navy or gray thermoplume (down) jacket with WH logo
- Navy blazer with WH logo
- Navy rain jacket with WH logo
- Crewneck Sweatshirts: navy, white, light blue, gray with WH logo
- Navy, white, gray cardigan with WH logo
- Tie in clear blue plaid
- Hair bows or headbands in navy, white, light blue, or clear blue plaid

#### Pants/Shorts, Skirts/Skorts, Jumpers/Dresses

(MUST be longer than fingertips. All skirts, dresses, and jumpers <u>must</u> have coverage underneath)

- Pants/Shorts: khaki, navy, light blue, gray
- Skirts/Skorts: khaki, navy, light blue, gray, white, clear blue plaid
- Jumper: khaki, classic navy, gray, clear blue plaid
- Dress: khaki, classic navy, light blue, gray with WH logo

# Footwear, Leggings, and Belts

- Shoes: closed toe, athletic shoes, boots, or flat sandals. Crocs, slippers, flip flops, and high heels are not permitted. Lower school must have closed-back shoes.
- Leggings/Tights/Socks: solid color white, navy, light blue, black or gray. Leggings or tights that are torn, see through, ripped, fishnets, etc. are not permitted.

# **INFORMATION FOR ALL**

Hair/Headgear/Hats: Hair for males and females must be neatly combed and in natural hair colors (such as black, brown, blonde, or red as opposed to dyed blue, purple, etc.). Males must keep hair trimmed above the eyebrows, ears, and collar and maintain a clean-shaven face with sideburns above the earlobe. Girls may wear headbands or bows in white, navy, light blue, or clear blue plaid. Hats or caps may not be worn inside any buildings on campus during the school day, and no other head coverings or wraps are allowed.

**Other:** Visible piercings of nose, eyebrows, lips, etc. (no clear studs), jewelry on the face, extreme makeup, as well as permanent, temporary, or drawn tattoos are not permitted. Pierced ears are allowed for girls only.

**Spirit Day:** Each Friday is a Wilson Hall Spirit Day. All students may choose to wear any color Wilson Hall gear to show their school spirit: sweatshirts, hoodies, t-shirts, jerseys, etc. representing an athletic team, academic organization, community service project, or fine arts event. Shirts must be tucked in on Spirit Days as well. These tops may be worn with any school appropriate jeans, pants, shorts, or skirts. Clothing may not have any rips or frays and must have finished hems. Camouflage and tie dye are not allowed.

<u>Jerseys/Team Shirts</u>: A coach may designate which shirt or jersey the team wears on Spirit Fridays to be unified and identifiable as a team or may opt to allow the students' choice. Teams that make it to region or state championship games may wear their jerseys or team shirts on the day of their games even if it is on a Monday - Thursday. The coach makes the final decision and those jerseys or shirts must be worn with approved uniform bottoms if not on a Spirit Day Friday.

**PS3 - 5th Grade Addendum:** Any day of the week students in PS3-5th grade may wear Wilson Hall hoodies or sweatshirts that are white, navy, light blue, or gray. Other colored shirts are not permitted inside the building.

**PE for Lower School Students:** On their assigned PE day, students in PS3 - 5th grade may wear regular uniform attire or approved PE uniform and tennis shoes. Approved PE uniforms consist of athletic pants/shorts in classic navy or gray and an approved Lands' End or Cubby Hole PE top. PE t-shirts must be tucked in all day except during PE class. Other athletic clothing is not allowed since lower school students will wear it all day. PE uniforms are only allowed on that student's PE day, not other days of the week.

**PE for Middle and High School Students:** During the scheduled PE period, students in grades 6 - 12 may wear any Wilson Hall t-shirt or sweatshirt with solid navy or gray athletic pants/shorts. A small white side stripe or piping on the pants/shorts is allowed. Lands' End athletic shorts or similar length styles are the only type of shorts permitted. Yoga pants, leggings, and other Nike style shorts are not permitted.

<u>Field Trips</u>: Middle and High School students wear uniforms on all field trips unless the trip coordinator tells them otherwise (i.e. if they have to wear dressy attire or athletic attire).

**Special Dress:** Administration will determine any additional Spirit Days and announce them in advance. Special consideration will be given for awards days, class challenge, field day, spirit week, teams in region or state play-off games, etc.

<u>Uniform Donation Closet / Buy Back Program</u>: Please do not donate Wilson Hall uniform pieces to charities; instead, please donate them back to the school for the uniform closet. Contact the upper school office for instructions on donating gently used items. Representatives from PTO & faculty manage a private Facebook page called Wilson Hall Uniform Exchange where parents buy and sell gently used uniform items. All posts must be uniform related or will be removed from the page. We hope to host an in person consignment sale in the future.

<u>THE BOTTOM LINE:</u> EVERY MONDAY - THURSDAY STUDENTS WEAR WILSON HALL CIRCLE LOGO ATTIRE ON THE TOP HALF OF THEIR BODY WITH APPROVED PANTS/SHORTS/SKORTS/DRESSES ON THE BOTTOM HALF.

Consequences for Dress Code Violations: Students who arrive at school or school functions dressed inappropriately as determined by administrators or teachers will be asked to correct the offense immediately. Depending on the offense, the student may be asked to change, serve detention, shave, or wear a particular item for ten days (i.e.: wear approved pants for a skirt infraction). The student will not be allowed to attend class until dress code is corrected, therefore, resulting in a tardy. If the student does not have clothing to change into, items to correct the infraction may be billed to your FACTS/SIS account.

All items may be purchased through the online Wilson Hall School Store at Lands' End, www.landsend.com/school, using school code: 900192394. Items can also be purchased through the Wilson Hall Uniform Exchange Facebook page or through the Wilson Hall Cubby Hole. For the sake of convenience, the Lands' End online store includes only the items/options approved for Wilson Hall students in PS3 through twelfth grade. If it is on our Wilson Hall Lands' End site, it is approved. Extra items (bookbags, lunch boxes, beach towels, etc.) are available on the Wilson Hall Lands' End site but are not required. Watch for Lands' Ends special discounts and sales.

All clothing should be purchased in true size, not overly baggy or tight. Student names should be written on the inside tags of all clothing since everyone's items look the same.
