

Dear Parents and Students,

Research indicates that student retention of material is improved when consistent review and practice occurs; therefore, Wilson Hall students will be enrolled into a Summer Math program. The Summer Math program will help students maintain their readiness for their next math class through a series of small online assignments.

Wilson Hall will run its upper school Summer Math program through *Delta Math*, an online program. *Delta Math* will run on any updated/modern browser, but Google Chrome is preferred and can be downloaded for free. *Delta Math* can help students reach a mastery of crucial prerequisite skills for their upcoming math classes by providing sample problems, practice, and immediate feedback to students. Tutorial videos are also available for most concepts.

**WHO:** Summer Math is a requirement for **ALL** rising 6th -12th grade students.

**MATERIALS:** Students will need internet access to complete the assignments. All assignments are conducted through the *Delta Math* website at [www.deltamath.com](http://www.deltamath.com).

**START DATE:** Students will enroll into *Delta Math* as soon as possible (see below), but the Summer Math assignments will not be accessible until **July 1st**.

**HOW TO ENROLL:**

1. Go to the *Delta Math* website and click “create account” in the top right corner.
  - \*A student who already has an account should:
    - Log in as normal.
    - Select “tools” in the top right corner.
    - Select “add teacher or access code”.
    - Special note: If a student is having trouble logging on or the program is running slow, clearing the browser history may troubleshoot the issue.
2. Enter the teacher code.
  - Each student will receive the teacher code and his/her math course placement.
3. Use your first and last name, WH issued email address, and WH issued password to create your account.
4. Join the correct class.
  - Rising 6th graders will join their rising grade level.
  - 7th through 12th graders will join by next year’s class name.

**DUE DATE:** All assignments must be completed by **August 21nd at 11:59 PM**. Completion is tracked online and will count as a quiz grade.

**DETAILS:**

- Multiple assignments exist per grade level/class; think of these as “categories” of math concepts. (Ex: fractions)
  - Students may work on the assignments in any order.
- Under each assignment, different skills are practiced. (Ex: adding fractions)
  - Students may work on the skills in any order; a student does not need to complete one skill to move on to another.
- Incorrect answers will incur a penalty, but this does not prevent students from still earning full credit; the program will simply require you to complete additional questions in order to receive full credit.

**GRADING:**

- Students do not have to do anything to “submit” their assignment. Although students are encouraged to work problems out on paper, no written work will ever be turned in.
- The website tracks and records their progress and completion. When the “Complete %” is 100%, the student is finished with an assignment. To ensure the entire Summer Math program is completed, a student should be certain that ALL assignments show 100% completion.
- **A major test assessment on these skills will be administered on Monday, August 22nd during class.**
