- Four 1" Heavy-duty binders: must be in the colors red (Math), green (Science), white (Literature), & blue (Social Studies) \*Please do **not** set these up on your own. You will receive specific instructions on how they should be organized when school begins.\*
- 2 Packages of dividers (Literature, & Social Studies)
- 75 Sheet protectors (Math, Writing, & Social Studies)
- 1 folder with 2 pockets (no prongs) (Literature)
- 1 folder with 2 pockets and prongs (Writing)
- Expo markers (1 red, 1 blue, 1 black to be turned in for Math and 2 of any color to keep in bookbag)
- 2 Composition books (Writing and Theatre)
- 1 pack of lined 3x5 index cards (Social Studies & Science)
- Small box for index cards
- Loose leaf paper – enough for all classes/binders
- Graph paper
- Calculator - simple (+, -, x & ÷)
- Pencil pouch or box
- Highlighters: **must include** blue, green, yellow, pink, orange, and purple (If you have trouble finding purple, it can be made by overlapping pink and blue.)
- Red, black, and blue pens
- Pencils, extra lead, and cap erasers
- Box of colored pencils
- 1 Glue stick
- Scissors
- Brown paper grocery bags to cover textbooks (Silicone book cover, jumbo size with reinforced corners is highly recommended but not required for math textbook)
