Wilson Hall's uniform policy exists to promote education in an environment that lessens distractions, increases a sense of community, and teaches the value of professional attire. To that end, the dress code will be followed; however, this dress code is meant to be a guide. The administration reserves the right to disallow anything that contradicts the spirit of the uniform dress code

Collared Shirts Male students must wear a collared WH circle logo shirt on Monday-Thursday. Collared shirts must be tucked in. Sweatshirts & Sweaters All sweatshirts, sweaters, vests, blazers, and quarter zips must be worn with a collared WH circle logo shirt underneath. (Wilson Hall hoodies are allowed on Fridays only.) Skirts must be uniform style, not athletic, and must have no ruffles or slits. (Cargo pants, flared yoga-style pants, canvas work-style pants, and excessively baggy pants—in either size or length—are not permitted.)
 Footwear and Belts Shoes: closed-toe, boots, or athletic shoes. Crocs, slippers, and flip-flops are not permitted. Socks: ankle or crew in solid colors white, navy, light blue, khaki, black, gray (no prints or bright colors) Belts: brown, black, gray, tan, or navy belts must be worn with pants or shorts that have belt loops. 	 Footwear and Leggings Shoes: closed-toe, boots, athletic shoes, or flat sandals. Crocs, slippers, flip flops, and high heels are not permitted. Leggings/Tights/Socks: solid color white, navy, light blue, black or gray. Leggings or tights that are torn, see-through, ripped, etc., are not permitted.

ALL STUDENTS

Hair/Headgear/Hats: Hair must be neatly groomed, kept out of the eyes, and in natural colors. Male students must keep hair trimmed above the eyebrows, ears, and collar, and must remain clean-shaven with sideburns no longer than the bottom of the earlobe. Students not in compliance with hair guidelines will receive a warning and must correct the issue within 48 hours; male students out of shaving compliance may be asked to shave immediately. Female students may wear headbands or bows in white, navy, light blue, or Clear Blue Plaid. Hats, caps, and other head coverings are not permitted during the school day.

<u>Other:</u> Visible piercings of the nose, eyebrows, lips, etc. (no clear studs), jewelry on the face, extreme makeup, writing on skin, and permanent or temporary tattoos are not permitted. Pierced ears are allowed for girls only.

Spirit Day: Each Friday is a Wilson Hall Spirit Day. All students may choose to wear any color Wilson Hall gear to show their school spirit: sweatshirts, hoodies, t-shirts, jerseys, etc., representing an athletic team, academic organization, community service project, or fine arts event. Shirts must be tucked in on Spirit Days. These tops may be worn with school-appropriate pants: any color jeans, shorts, skirts, or approved uniform shorts, pants, or skirts. Clothing may not have any rips or excessive frays and must have neat hemlines. Camouflage and tie-dye are not allowed. Students who are dressed inappropriately on a Spirit Day will be asked to change immediately and may receive disciplinary action for inappropriate attire.

Jerseys/Team Shirts: A coach may designate which shirt or jersey the team wears on Spirit Fridays to be unified and identifiable as a team or may opt to allow the students' choice. Teams that make it to region or state championship games may wear their jerseys or team shirts on the day of their games, even if it is on a Monday-Thursday. The coach makes the final decision, and those jerseys or shirts must be worn with approved uniform bottoms if not on a Spirit Day.

<u>Lower School PE</u>: On their assigned PE day, students in PS3 - 5th grade may wear regular uniform attire or approved PE uniform and tennis shoes. Approved PE uniforms consist of athletic pants/shorts in classic navy or gray and an approved Lands' End or Cubby Hole PE top. PE t-shirts must be tucked in all day except during PE class. Other athletic clothing is not allowed since lower school students will wear it all day. PE uniforms are only allowed on that student's PE day, not other days of the week.

<u>Middle School PE Classes</u>: During the scheduled PE and weight lifting class period, students in grades 6-8 may wear any Wilson Hall t-shirt or sweatshirt with the Lands' End navy or gray athletic pants/shorts. Land's End athletic pants/shorts with the Wilson Hall circle logo are the only bottoms that are permitted. Yoga pants, leggings, athletic skirts, and Nike-style shorts are not permitted.

<u>Field Trips:</u> Lower, Middle, and High School students wear uniforms on all field trips unless the trip coordinator tells them otherwise (i.e., if they have to wear dressy attire or athletic attire).

Special Dress: Administration will determine any additional Spirit Days and announce them in advance. Special consideration will be given for awards programs, Class Challenge, Field Day, Spirit Week, teams in region or state play-off games, etc.

<u>Uniform Donation Closet:</u> Please do not donate Wilson Hall uniform pieces to charities; instead, please donate them back to the school for our uniform closet. Contact the Upper School office for instructions on donating gently used items. Representatives from PTO & faculty manage a private Facebook page called Wilson Hall Uniform Exchange where parents buy and sell gently used uniform items. All posts must be uniform-related. If not, the post will be removed from the page.

THE BOTTOM LINE: On any given day, hair must be neatly combed and kept away from the eyes. From Monday through Thursday, students are required to wear a collared Wilson Hall circle logo uniform shirt with an approved uniform bottom. All skirts and shorts must be longer than fingertip length. Fridays are designated Wilson Hall Spirit Days, and any other special dress days will be announced in advance.

Consequences for Dress Code Violations: Students who arrive at school or school functions dressed inappropriately, as determined by administrators or faculty members, will be asked to correct the offense immediately. The student will not be allowed to attend class until the infraction is corrected, therefore, possibly resulting in a tardy. All dress code infractions will be emailed to the parent and noted in the student's Behavior Tab in FACTS. Multiple dress code infractions may result in additional consequences as determined by administration.

All items may be purchased through the online **Wilson Hall School Store at Lands' End, www.landsend.com/school**, using school code: **900192394**. Items can also be purchased through the Wilson Hall Uniform Exchange Facebook page or through the Wilson Hall Cubby Hole. For the sake of convenience, the Lands' End online store includes only the items/options approved for Wilson Hall students in PS3 through twelfth grade. If it is on our Wilson Hall Lands' End site, it is approved. Extra items (bookbags, lunch boxes, beach towels, etc.) are available on the Wilson Hall Lands' End site but are not required. Watch for Lands' Ends special discounts and sales. All clothing should be purchased in true size, not overly baggy or tight. Student names should be written on the inside tags of all clothing since everyone's items look the same.
